American Indian Studies at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign seeks two Postdoctoral Fellows for the 2021-2022 academic year. Stipend and Benefits: The Fellowship stipend for the 2021-2022 academic year is \$47,476, including health benefits. An additional \$5,000 will be provided for the fellow's research, travel, and related expenses.

Minimum Qualifications: Ph.D. or equivalent terminal degree is required. Candidates must have completed all degree requirements by August 15, 2021. Preference will be given to those applicants who have finished their degrees in the past five years. The one-year fellowship is a 9/12 appointment from August 16, 2021 through August 15, 2022 with service dates from August 16, 2021 through May 15, 2022.
